A Strategic Framework for CAREC 2011-2020

CI Operational Program for 2016

- Infrastructure development (\$500 bln investment for 2010-2020, improving connectivity, increasing productive capacities);
- Transport and trade facilitation (multimodal transport regime, cost and time, crossing borders, transit, trade cost);
- Economic diversification and specialization (comparative advantage, food security, energy security, SME development).

- What are the needs for transport infrastructure investment in 2016-2030?
- Transport infrastructure as a basis for economic activities across regional borders.
