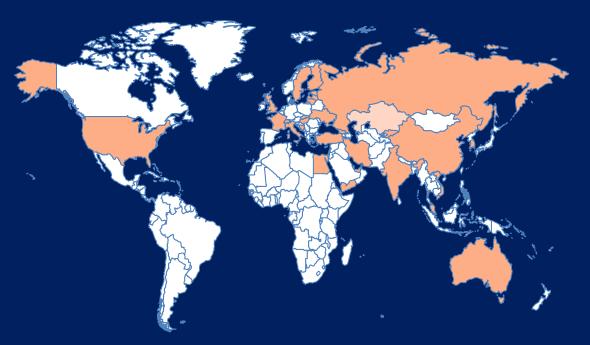

Current status of e-commerce development in Kazakhstan

- > In 2021, the size of the B2C e-commerce market is **KZT 1.3 trillion**
- > Share of e-commerce in the total retail trade is 9.6%
- ➤ Since 2022, an e-commerce school has been launched in partnership with the leading global payment company Mastercard
- Draft Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan «On Protection of Consumer Rights» ecommerce has been conceptualized
- > E-commerce enterprises in Kazakhstan are exempt from income tax until 2023
- Wildberries 9,000 thousand Kazakh entrepreneurs
- Alibaba.com more than 4 thousand Kazakh goods and 150 companies
- Amazon direct access to registration for Kazakh companies



Best case of successful fintech company in Kazakhstan that became country's largest online e-commerce platform as well

According to the last Kaspi report, the results for 1Q 2022

- Marketplace +50% GMV YoY
- mobile-Commerce GMV up 66% YoY
- > e-Grocery GMV and purchases up 23x & customers up 10x YoY
- Kaspi Postomats already 9% of e-Commerce deliveries
- Kaspi Travel is already 9% of total Marketplace
- > e-Commerce deliveries up 107% YoY
- > Share of delivery reached 91% in 1Q22



Merchants up 252% and consumers up 23% YoY
