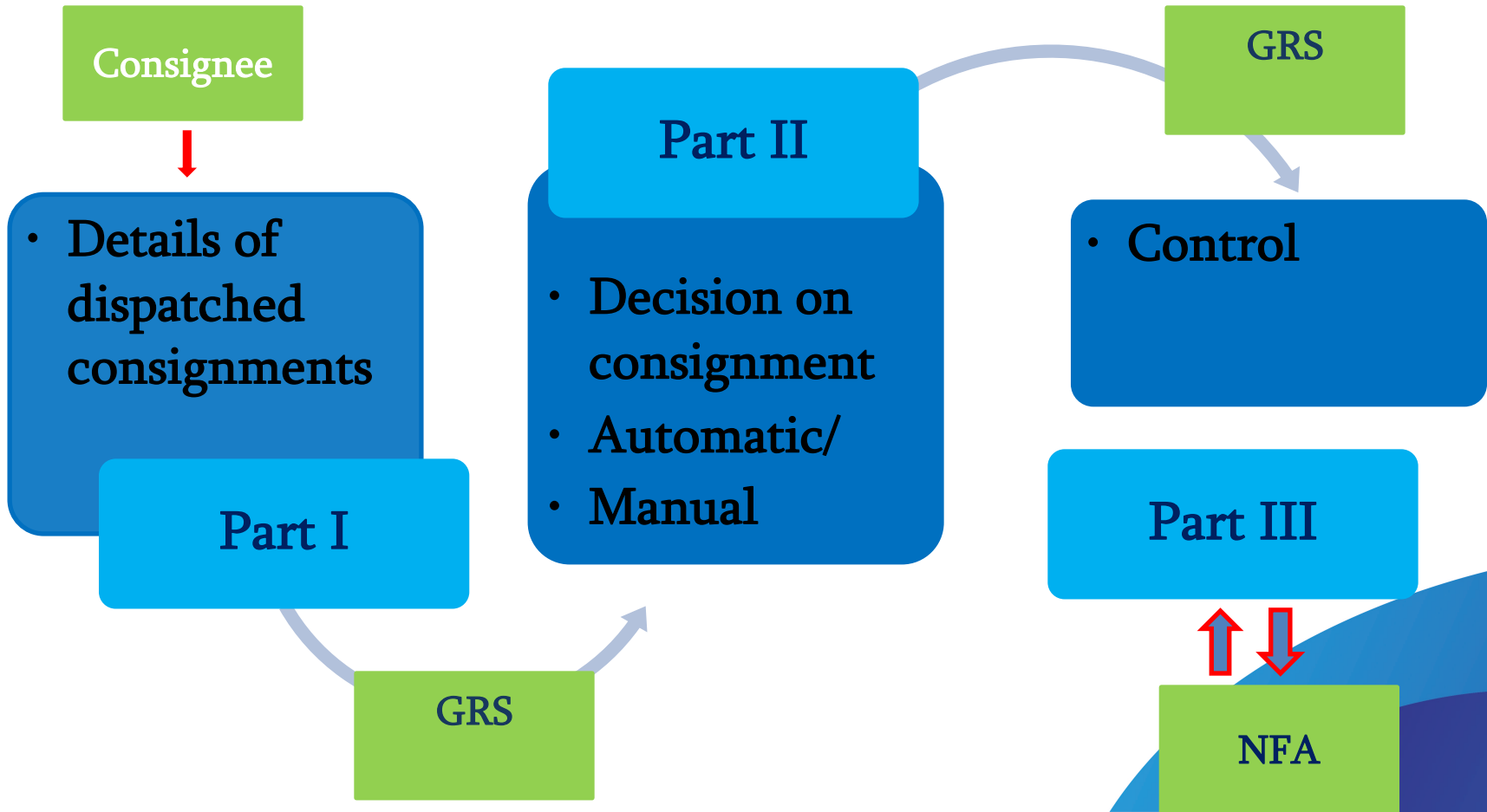

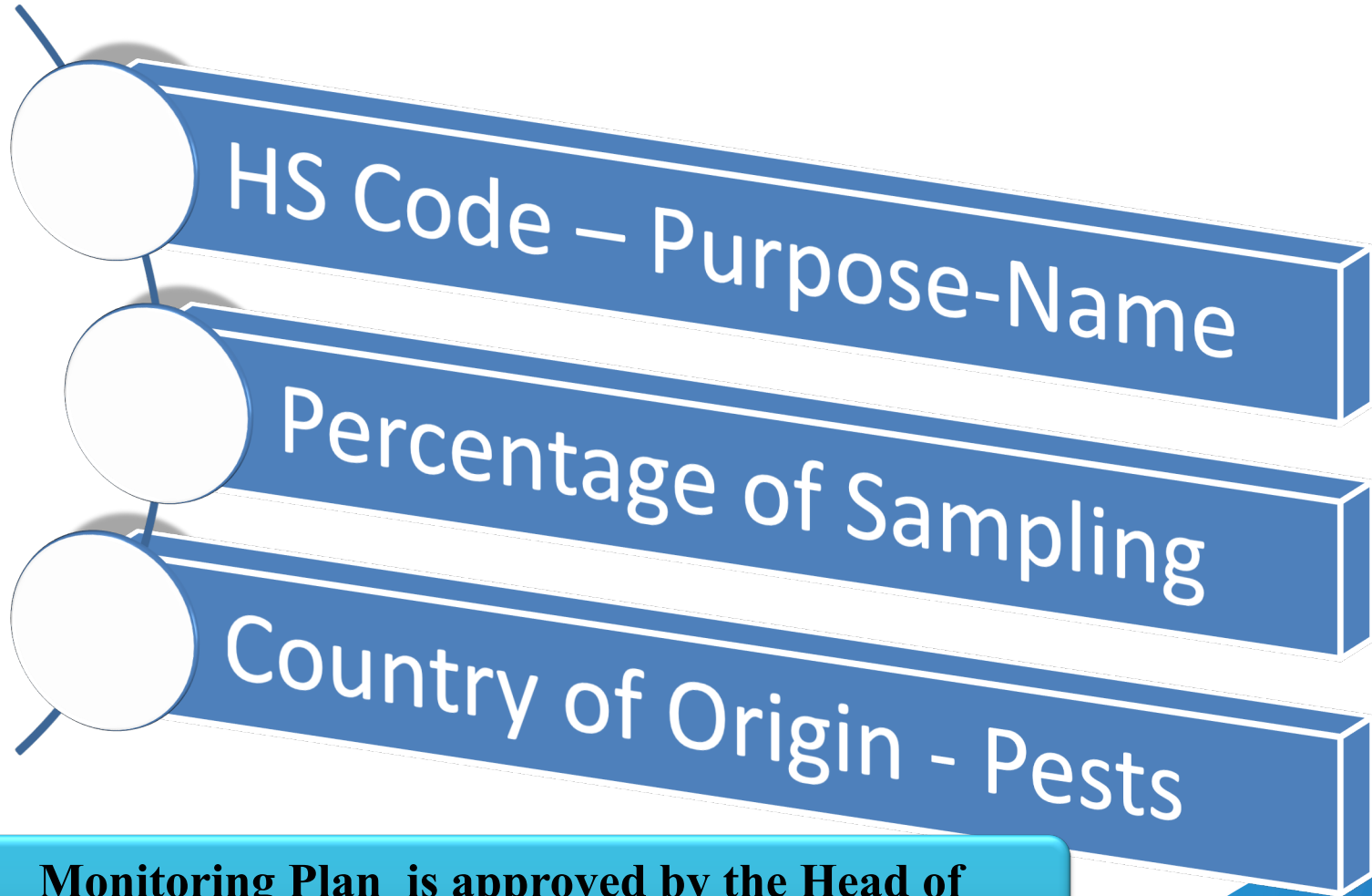


CEVD (Common Entry Veterinary Document) – GRS development





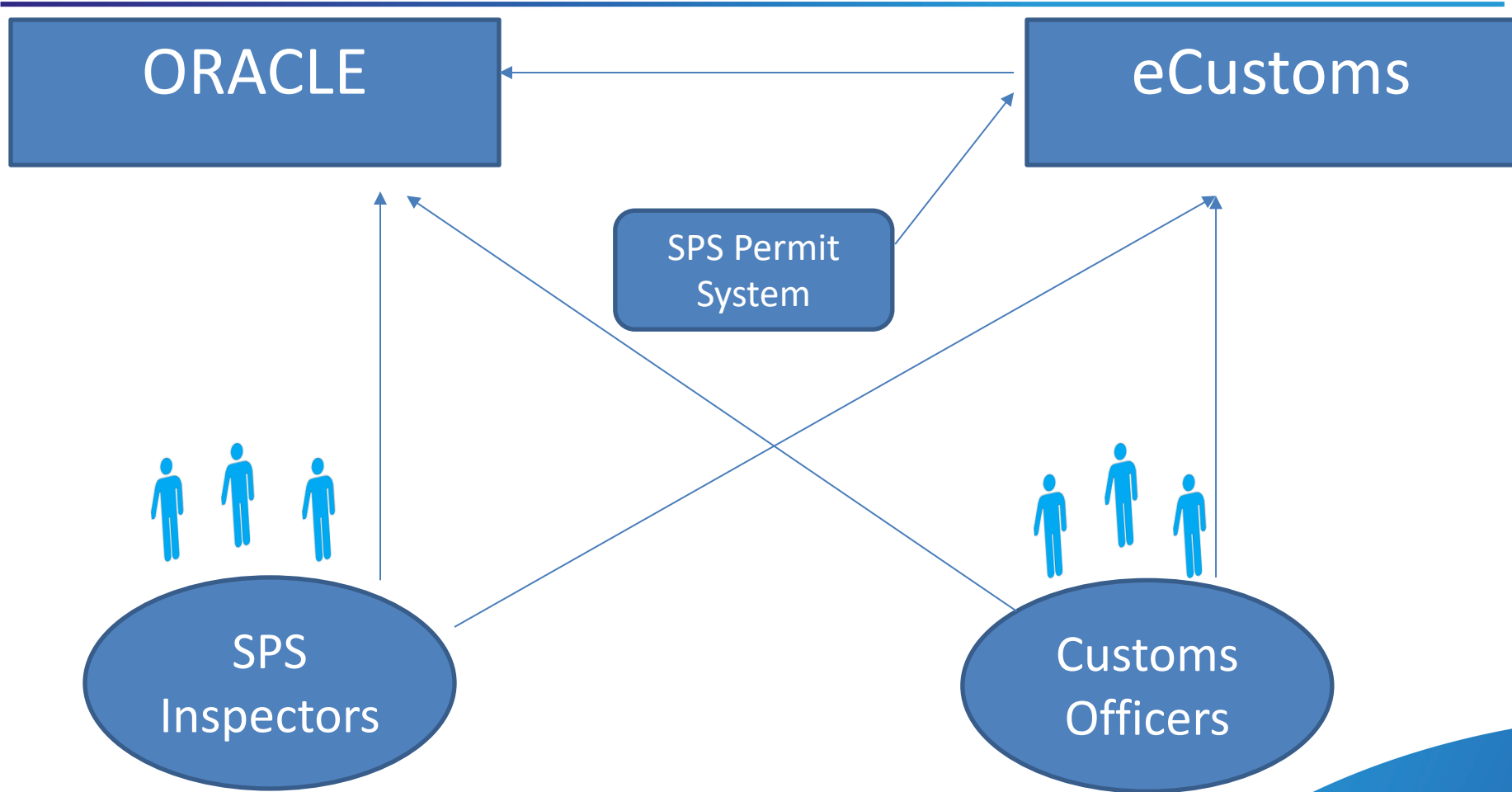
Monitoring plan



- **Monitoring Plan** is approved by the Head of Georgia Revenue Service in agreement with the National Food Agency and on risk based approach

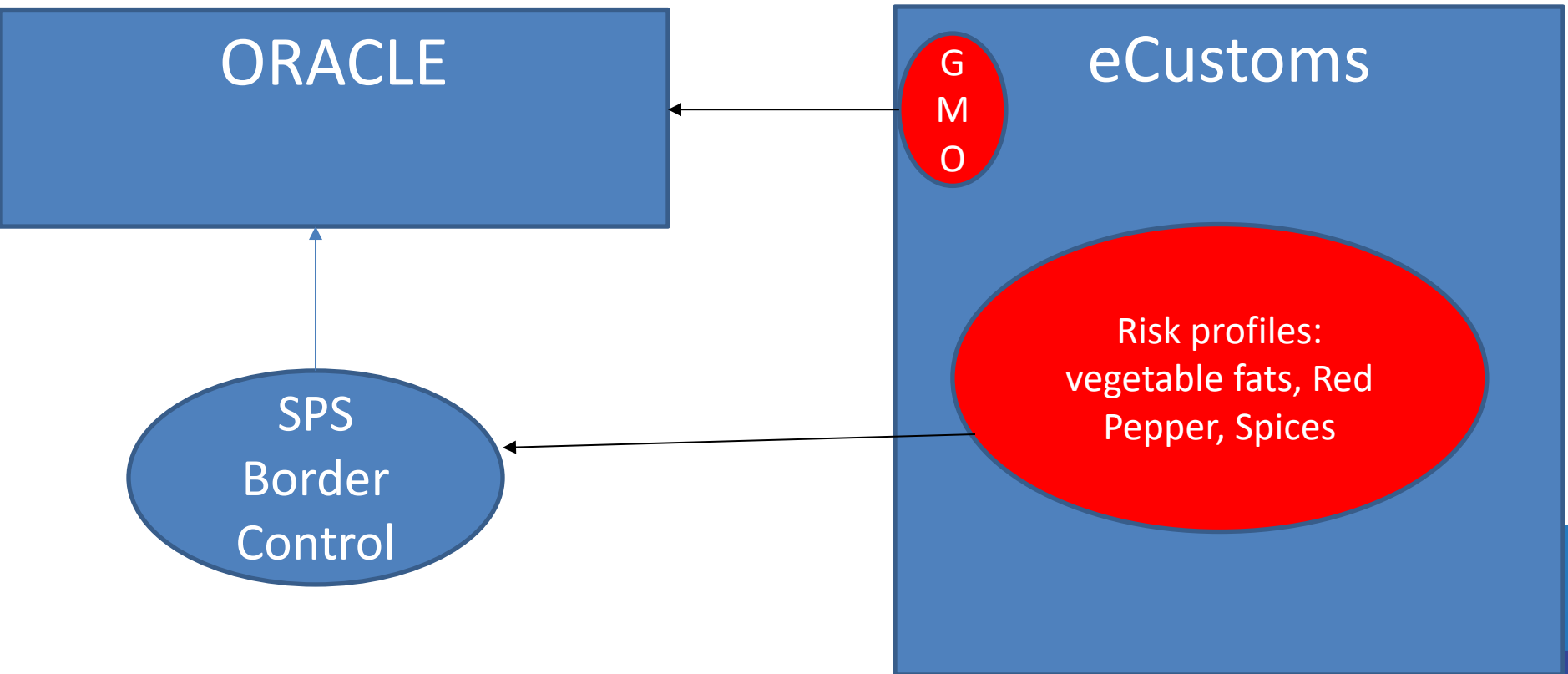


Integrated systems SPS-Customs Control



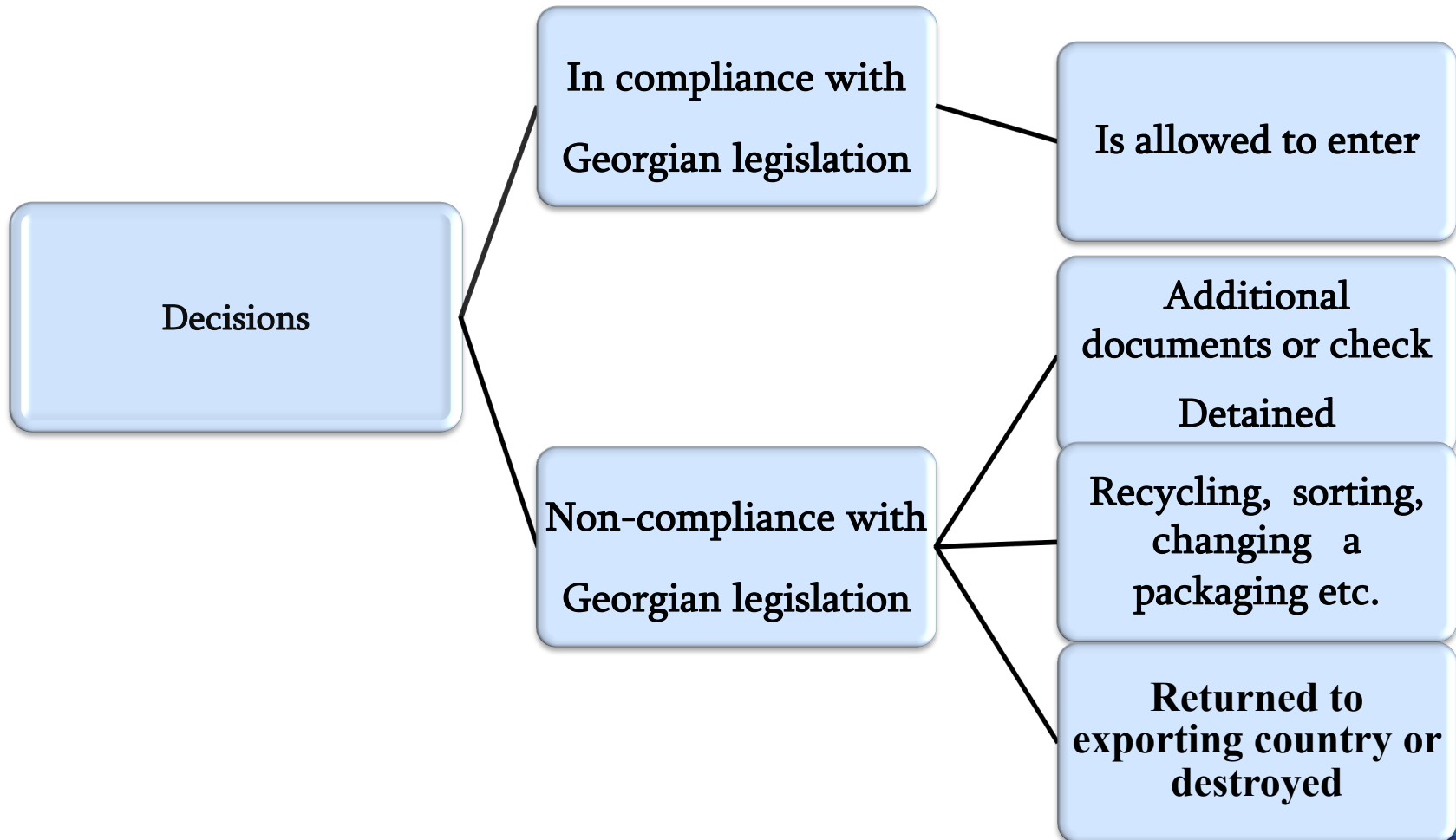

Veterinary Control/Export

- On the Border Inspection Post Veterinary export certificate mandatory in case of live animals and raw hides and skins and leather (codes 4101, 4102, 4103)
- Certificates for other products is regulated according to veterinary requirements of importing country
- Veterinary export certificate is issued by Revenue Service and National Food Agency
