Trade Facilitation



- "Measures that aims to increase the costeffectiveness of international trade transactions".
- "the simplification and harmonization of international trade procedures."



Trade Facilitation (TF) in Asia and the Pacific

- On average ESCAP-wide, it still takes <u>30 days</u> to move goods from factory to deck of ship at nearest seaport
 - ASEAN still takes about <u>15 days!</u>
 - G-7 export time is now at 10 days!
- ESCAP research shows that intra-regional trade costs are higher than those with Europe and North America
- Improvements in TF could bring \$250 billion in additional intraregional trade
