 Corridor 1: Irkeshtam BCP – Sary-Tash – Gulcha – Osh is part of the CAREC international transport corridor 2 linking China with the Caspian region

• Corridor 2: Irkeshtam BCP – Sary-Tash – Karamyk is part of the CAREC international transport corridors 3 and 5, and is a very important transit route from PRC to Tajikistan. The corridor is also used to deliver cargo to Afghanistan along the Northern Distribution Network.

- •We began supplying goods through corridor # 5 from PRC to Afghanistan (+ ADB project)


