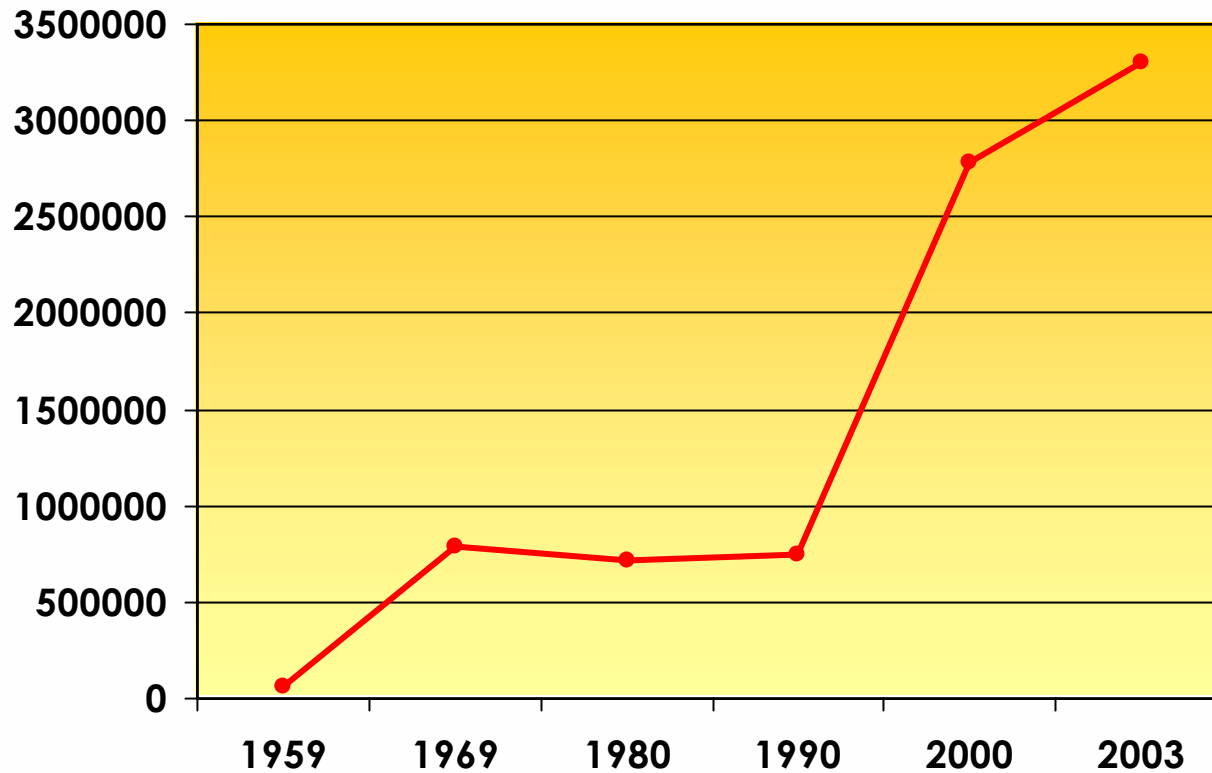

## Security

- Goods are carried in sealed vehicles or containers which are approved for use by Customs and re-approved every two years



## International Guarantee

- Duties and taxes due in case of irregularity are secured by international guarantee throughout the journey

## Transit or Customs Delay

- TIR Carnet cargo is subject to fewer delays and enjoys more expeditious delivery
- Allows consignee to respond quickly to questions or problems



## Customs Control

- Control measures taken in the country of departure are accepted by countries of transit and destination



## Controlled Access

- Access to the TIR system for national issuing and guaranteeing associations and transport operators are given by competent national authorities

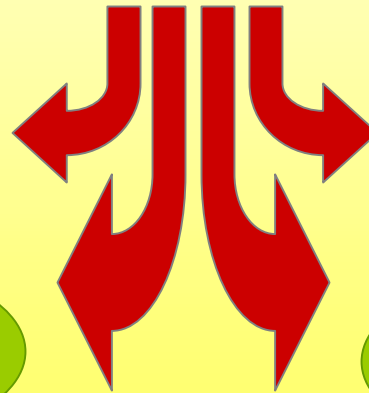
