





Bangkok Port Customs Bureau

The Bureau is responsible for:

- a. Customs formalities, duty and tax collection, vehicle and cargo control, examination and clearance of imported and exported goods, transshipment goods, and in-transit goods within the Bangkok Port;
- b. enforcement of Customs and related laws and regulations;
- c. disposal of seized and unclaimed goods.



Import Clearance: One Stop Service





EDI Import Clearance Procedure



Importers enter invoice and Declaration data into computer and electronically transmit it to Customs





Customs computer verifies the received data, assigns Declaration number and inspection condition (Green/Red



Importers submit documents for further verification at Customs Formalities Division



Importers print out verified Declaration



Tax and duty payment at Customs cashiers

Importers submit Declaration and supporting documents to warehouses



Cargo not subject to inspection

Customs electronically verifies manifest against Declaration and instructs cargo inspection

Cargo subject to inspection

Cargo released

Importers arrange goods for inspection



Release Cargo from Custody


Delivery (Public Sector) Inspected 10% Not Inspected [Exempted] 90% (Private Sector)

Release Cargo From Custody

- Delivery : Public Sector
- Exempted : Private Sector
- Both follow same procedure
- The inspection officer orders the PAT
 officer to deliver the Cargo to the importer




Container Inspection System

The Objective of Cargo Release

To check actual payment of duty by checking the description of goods, quantity, quality, weight, value and applying the correct tariff and other related duties (VAT, Excise tax etc)

IPR GOODS

- Direct Contract to Right Owner within 24 Hrs.
- 2. Prove: Its fake or not fake
- 3. Prove by Authorize Person
- 4. All cost is to be paid by them
- 5. Release ...or...Seize, Legal Process


