- Entry Encoding Center (EEC)

PCCI-BOC Computerized Lodgment Facilities

- Improvement in cargo clearance procedures
- Reduction of human discretion
- Increase in transparency and efficiency
- Improvement in surveillance and monitoring of incoming and outgoing shipments

PCCI-BOC Computerized Lodgment Facilities

- Current infrastructure no longer adequate
- Program enhancements needed

BOC Computerization

- No upgrade of computerized system since 1992 given manifold increase in volume of transactions
- Resulted in delays, high costs, pilferage and security problems
- Possible loss of revenues

Manual processing as stop-gap solution

BOC Computerization PCCI Proposal

Long-term solution

- Provide enhancements at no cost to the government
- Bid out project to IT companies
- Charge reasonable fees to recover costs

Installation of X-Ray Container System

- Current manual container inspection prone human discretion, pilferage, and security risks
- Global call for heightened security to intercept prohibited items

Installation of X-Ray Container System

- Philippine ports at par with the world's leading ports
- Speedy, accurate and efficient inspection process
- For transparency and verification

Installation of X-ray Container System PCCI Proposal

- Participation of private port operators and Philippine Ports Authority for funding
- Charge fees to recover costs

Conclusion

- Strategic importance of proactive participation and partnership with BOC
- Business community to benefit from enhancements in procedures and processes in BOC
- Be prepared for global competition
