

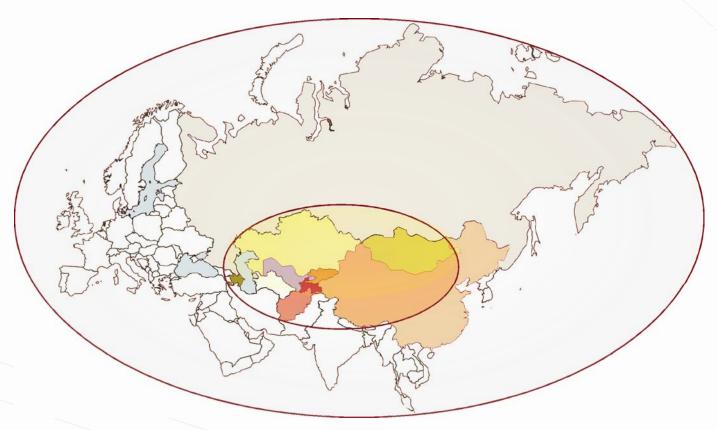

DIFFICULTIES IN TRANSIT FREIGHT FLOWS DEVELOPMENT

ADB identified about 20 barriers which can be divided into:

- contributing a private sector perspective to CAREC transport and trade facilitation efforts
- supporting relevant government agencies in improving transport and trade facilitation policies and infrastructure

CFCFA TASKS FOR 2010-2011

SHORT-TERM TASKS:

Along with the tasks on organization of CFCFA activity and financing, the following tasks are determined:

- 1. common schedule of work of customs authorities at the main Kazakhstan-China crossing points
- 2. implementation of project on CIM/SMGS single consignment note
- 3. trainings for transport business with participation of international experts
- 4. creation of CFCFA website
 - trading floor allowing to reduce empty movements
 - portal for information support of transportations

MIDDLE-TERM TASKS:

- 1. implementation of system for processing and transfer of preliminary information on cargo
- 2. formation of solidary (joint) insurance system
- 3. attraction of freight flows to CAREC corridor #2 through development of its technical potential on the basis of public private partnership
