- UNECE one of the five regional UN commissions

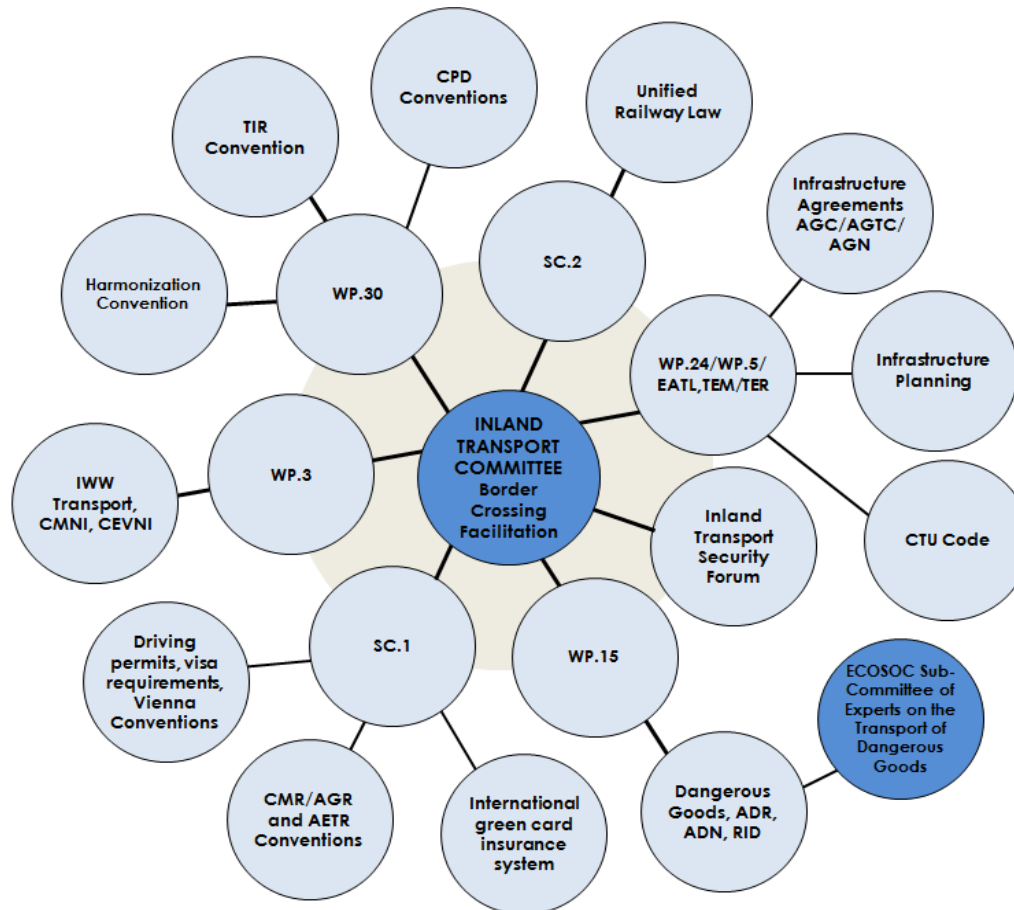
# UNECE

- UNECE secretariat in Geneva: 200 people

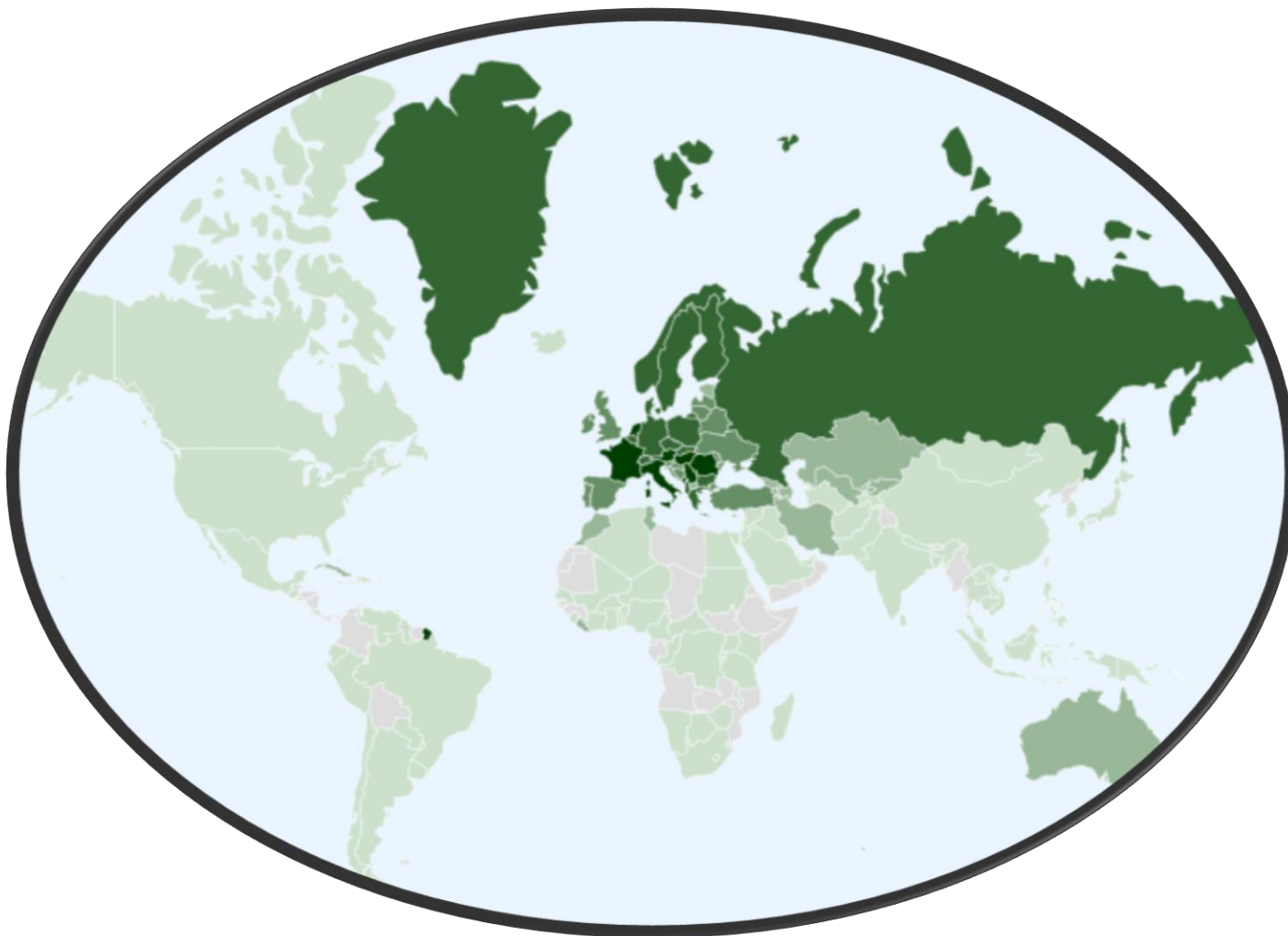

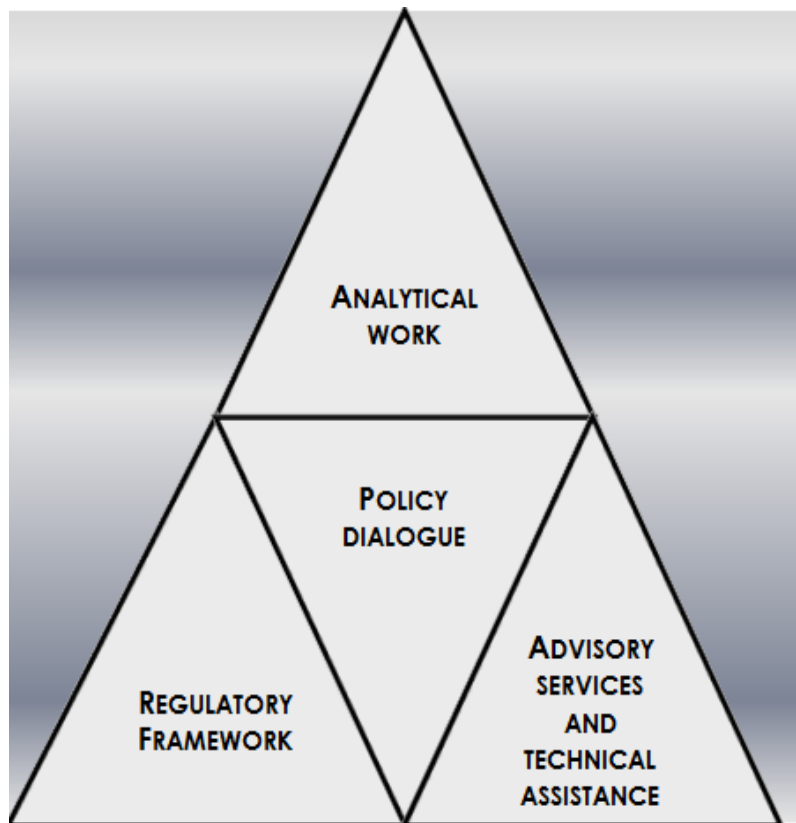
