Trade Facilitation Major Milestones

- TF program contributing to TTFS and CAREC 2020 objectives
- Evolution from customs work to integrated trade facilitation
- Engagement of private sector into trade facilitation development efforts
- Collecting and analyzing critical information on time and cost to transport goods along the 6 CAREC corridors



Customs Cooperation

- Substantial progress in aligning customs laws and regulations with international best practice
- All countries have streamlined and automated (in varying degrees) customs procedures; national single windows being developed
- Successful joint customs control pilots (e.g. harmonized cargo manifest); expansion to phase 2
- Piloting initiatives on regional transit
- Countries adopted risk management measures to minimize physical inspection



Integrated Trade Facilitation

- Single window development and paperless trade
- National joint transport and trade facilitation committees (NJCs)
- Regional Improvement of Border Services (RIBS) project
- Sanitary and Phytosanitary cooperation
- Trade logistics development
- Private sector participation CAREC Federation of Carrier and Forwarder Associations



Integrated Trade Facilitation (cont.)

- CFCFA a forum for private sector consultation
 - 17 national associations
 - Platform for capacity building to professionalize industry
 - www.cfcfa.net to disseminate information (BCP operating hours, news/updates, capacity building)
- Corridor Performance Measurement and Monitoring (CPMM)
 - 14 partner associations from CFCFA
 - Building capacity to perform country level analysis
 - Quarterly and annual reports available online
- CAREC Results Framework: Trade Facilitation Indicators (2010)

| Indicators | Averages |

Regional Improvement of Border Services (RIBS) Project

- 2 components: BCP infrastructure improvements & national SWs and inter-operability
- R-PPTA approved January 2011
- NJC workshop in Bangkok, January 2011
- No-objection received from all 8 countries
- Project focal points appointed by 7 countries except KAZ
- Lists of BCPs covered under RIBS submitted by 7 countries, except KAZ
- Portions of SWs of KGZ, MON and TAJ to be covered
- Background information from PRC, TAJ
- Consultants fielded in mid-May 2011
