- Statistical Data Exchange
 - In February of 2007 and in March of 2008, PRC Kyrgyz republic and Kazakhstan customs experts met in Beijing and Almaty studying and analyzing causes of discrepancies in trade statistics.

Progress Review

- Joint Customs Control
 - On 15 Dec. 2007, a pilot joint border inspection was initiated in Dulata (PRC) and Kalzhat (Kazakhstan).
 - PRC and Mongolia have established working groups for pilot projects.

Progress Review

- Capacity Building
 - Sponsored by ADB, training courses were conducted in Shanghai Customs College:
 - --- on the subject of Anti Smuggling in November 2007;
 - --- on Duty Collection in June 2008;
 - --- on Customs Inspection Technologies for Mongolia in June 2008.
