
Geographical Advantages For Afghanistan

- Possess lengthy common borders with Pakistan, Iran, Turkmenistan and Tajikistan & short borders with Uzbekistan and China.
- South-North Corridor (Afghanistan connects Central Asian Republics with Karachi port in the Arabian Sea).
- West-East Corridor (Afghanistan connects Central Asian Republics with Port of Bandar Abbas in the Persian Gulf).
- Vital link for TAP (Turkmenistan-Afghanistan-Pakistan Proposed Gas Pipeline).

Transit & Trade Facilitation.


- Solving barriers to trade.

Acquired Advantages. Post 9/11 Scenario.

- Afghanistan had signed bilateral and multilateral agreements on transit and transport with some ECO countries.
- Islam Qala-Herat-Kabul road constructed.
- Torkham-Jalalabad-Kabul road built.
- Hairathan-Mazar-Kabul road constructed.
- Torghundi-Herat road under construction.
- ASYCUDA transit module implemented at Torkham-Jalalabad-Kabul Corridor.
- All major border crossing points (13-BCPs) would be fully developed and automated.
- Plan to develop major ICDs is in advance stage.
