REGIONAL TRANSIT REGULATION

- Agreement between the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic and the Government of the Republic of Kazakhstan on transit movement of goods by motor-transport across the territory of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Bishkek, March 26, 2004.
- Agreement between the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic and the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan on transit movement of goods by motor-transport dated July 22, 2005.
- Agreements on guarantees and the Memorandum of Understanding among the customs services of the Kyrgyz Republic, the Association of international road transporters of the Kyrgyz Republic (KyrgyzASMAP) and International Road Transport Union on collection, transfer, processing and exchange of data on ceasing operations using TIR carnets, dated October 20, 2006 (Geneva).



REGIONAL TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT

- Bringing bylaws of the SCC in line with amended Agreement and the Memorandum
- Agreement between the KR SCC and the KyrgyzASMAP on the procedure for allowing motor transport and containers to be engaged in international cargo transportation using customs stamps and seals.



REGIONAL TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT

- SCC Order № 5-4/441 dated 24.11.2006 “On approval of the Temporary Regulation on the procedure of customs control of transportation for goods using TIR”
- Transfer of functions to the Kyrgyz ASMAP to permit vehicles to be engaged in transportation using customs stamps and seals (de-regulation of customs functions by a transfer to the Kyrgyz ASMAP)



REGIONAL TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT

Application of new technologies for transit arrangements:

- Application of safe-packages – is discussed jointly with the customs service of the Republic of Kazakhstan
- Applying GPS – pilot testing along the route Torugart – Naryn - Bishkek



REGIONAL TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT

- Discussing possibilities for mutual recognition of sage-packages in adjacent territories in the process of goods movement
- Discussing possibilities for using GPS/GLONASS to monitor the movement of goods in a real-time mode.

REGIONAL TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT

- Launching the project on mutual application of safe-packages at adjacent check points with further roll-out along the whole Kyrgyz-Kazakh state border.
- Integration of safe-packages into Joint Control
