Regional Transport and Logistics Information Portal and Development of the Electronic Road Atlas

- A suggestion to merge the projects for establishment of the logistics portal and electronic atlas (ADBL)
- To focus joint efforts of associations on CFCFA routes and use the CAREC Corridor data
- To use the project for further development of the CFCFA web-site and income generation

Improving Legal Knowledge of Drivers Engaged in International Road Transport Operations

- Confirmed the need for drivers' training
- The proposed project is to be considered later together with development the CFCFA's training system

International Road Waybill

Registration Certificates of Companies

- No uniform opinion in the WG on introduction of a new road waybill, so the issue is to be studied further
- Certificates can be issued and the database can be established with the support of CFCFA member associations (on their member companies)

Development of the Guidelines for CAREC Exporters

Given the challenges related to publication, to publish it in the electronic format and post it in the CFCFA web-site

Consideration of Issues Related to the Customs Union Establishment

Due to establishment of the Customs Union, a number of BCPs have been liquidated, delays and costs at the border have been reduced

There are many unresolved issues among the CU member countries, as well as between the CU member countries and other countries (VAT-related issues between KAZ and KGZ, using TIR carnets for customs transit)
