Progress on gender equality

- The newly updated Constitution of Uzbekistan reflects in article 58 the provision on the equal rights of women and men and that the State will ensure such equality in all areas of public and State life.
- A gender strategy for Uzbekistan until 2030 is being implemented. Since 2022, the Government has had a secretariat for family and women's issues, the Senate has a commission and a committee on achieving gender equality, and the Committee on Family and Women's Issues has resumed its work.
- Gender expertise and gender audit requirements are now in place. In all organisations and institutions, the position of an authorised person responsible for the implementation of gender policy has been introduced.



Challenges and future directions

- The level of representation of women in leadership positions in government bodies has not been reached in the country.
- Strengthening co-operation between state bodies on the representation of women in state administration bodies at the decision-making level.
