The State Committee for Family, Women and Children Affairs, Republic of Azerbaijan



THE STATE COMMITTEE:

- Central executive authority
- Implements and regulates state policy on family, women & children's issues
- Monitors gender equality and submits an annual report to the Parliament of the Republic of Azerbaijan

Role of the State Committee for Family, Women, and Children Affairs

It is mandated to undertake the following:

- propose legal acts,
- review and recommend state policies and programs,
- develop information systems for gender-related monitoring, and
- sign agreements with relevant bodies of foreign countries and international organizations.

The committee performs its role by using the following mechanisms:

- operates family support centers that provide information on services for women and children and to raise awareness on gender and family issues;
- trains relevant professionals within the public service on gender equality issues;
- undertakes or commissions research on gender-related issues;
- oversees the collection of necessary data and sex-disaggregated statistics;
- organizes roundtable discussions, seminars, and conferences on diverse gender equality issues in specific sectors of activity;
- participates in various multidisciplinary committees under other ministries;
- provides gender perspectives in formulating and implementing policies related to family, children, violence against women, employment, and social inclusion;
- engages with relevant civil society organizations to seek inputs into policy formulation and decision-making concerning women, children, and families.

11 Child & Family Support Centers

- Identify children and women in need of special care in community, and refer them to the existing social services
- Assist the children, especially children who are the victims of unfortunate circumstances, provide counseling, and psychological aid
