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AGREEMENT ON TRANS-AFGHAN TRANSPORT CORRIDOR



AGREEMENT on International Transportation Routes among the Transitional Islamic State of Afghanistan, the Islamic Republic of Iran and the Republic of Uzbekistan

The Transitional Islamic State of Afghanistan, the Islamic Republic of Iran and the Republic of Uzbekistan hereinafter referred to as "the Contracting Parties".

lichloring in friendly relations and mutual understanding and the necessity of matually beneficial cooperation,

having respect to independence, sovereignty, territorial integrity as well as non-interference into internal attaits of each other which constitute the basis of relations among nations,

expressing their desire to speed up far-reaching expansion of commercial and economic relations to the benefit of their nations and the region,

emphasizing on the vital importance of cooperation in the field of transportation and transit, in accordance with international rules and standards.

making accessible the communications and international maritime markets for the people of the region,

as well as in order to coordinate efforts to create international transportation routes via Afghanistan as a necessary eloment to contribute to the regional economic development.

have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The Contracting Parties, on the basis of mutually beneficial cooperation, shall take joint measures in order to speed up the creation of international transportation routes via their states and to provide for access to Europe, Central Asian countries. Persian Gulf and the Sea of Oman ports and international maritime links.

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
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

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
Trans-Afghan Railway Network (2,067 km)




Hairatan-Mazare-e-Sharif-Herat Railway Line




Shirkhan Bandar-Kabul-Torkham Railway Line
