



The CAREC Integrated Trade Agenda 2030 framework supports enhancing the measurement of at-theborder and behind-the-border procedures to promote lower trade costs and more effective trade facilitation in the region. In line with this, the workshop discussion will revolve around the improvements of the CPMM methodology and recommended practices in data collection.

The CAREC Program initiated a review of the CPMM with a view to enhancing its effectiveness in fostering the development of the CAREC Corridors. This workshop will introduce to the CPMM stakeholders, specifically its private-sector freight forwarder association partners, the focus shifts in data collection, validation, and dissemination. It will also discuss the issues encountered during the pilot implementation of the revised CPMM methodology and how to address them.







CPMM is a tool to assess the efficiency of CAREC transport corridors:

- i. identifies causes of delays and unnecessary costs along the CAREC corridor, including border-crossing points and intermediate stops.
- ii. helps authorities determine where and how to address identified bottlenecks.
- iii. assesses the impact of regional cooperation initiatives.

Main objective of the workshop

- 1. Implement the changes in 2025.
 - Review of the pilot conducted July-Dec 2024.
- 2. Seek feedback of changes from stakeholders.
 - Preliminary feedback obtained from April workshop in Samarkand.
- 3. Restructure data collection.
 - Focus on routes, instead of CAREC-level indicators; fewer and less frequent sample.
 - Focus on select BCPs; gather more qualitative information.
