

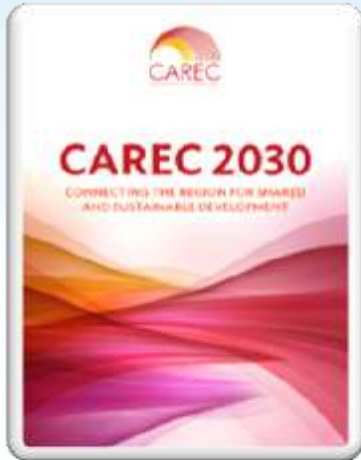

# Alignment of CAREC Transport Strategy with CAREC 2030 Strategy



- A Regional Cooperation Platform to Connect People, Policies, and Projects for Shared and Sustainable Development
- Infrastructure and Economic Connectivity Cluster – Objective:
  - *Enhanced economic connectivity, and increased sustainability and resilience of regional infrastructure*

- Implementation of the Railway Strategy










## Aviation

- Addressing specific country needs and conditions
- Aligned to CAREC Transport Strategy, hence with each other
- Contain specific country objectives and targets
- Based on specific national implementation arrangements
- Approved as the national regulatory act with assigned responsibilities and accountability



# CAREC Transport Results Measurement and Monitoring

Lessons	Revised approach
<b>Aggregated reporting:</b> Not informative, no accountability	<b>Disaggregated information:</b> DMCs will receive reports by country and by corridors to support their national actions
<b>Cumulative data reporting:</b> Total progress achieved since approval of the Strategy, but low visibility of trends, low explanatory value	<b>Reporting of trends and changes:</b> Analysis of changes and factor contributing to improved transport systems
<b>Focus on numbers:</b> Achievements are reported, but not explained	<b>Focus on knowledge:</b> Performance indicators will be supplemented by knowledge products to support decisions of national transport authorities



# Implementation Approaches & Tools

- The CAREC program will now strongly focus on implementation following Think Regionally – Act Locally approach
- CAREC Program will significantly upscale analytical and advisory support to the CAREC DMCs
- New Knowledge Products will be developed to support DMCs governments in making high level policy and financial decisions on various transport decisions
- More knowledge and advisory services will be provided at the national level in response to demand from specific DMCs
- CAREC program will invite financial support from multilateral and bilateral partners to upscale technical assistance funding
- Strong partnership with the CAREC Institute for the regional analytical and training activities



# Transport Strategy 2030 Preparation

- Initiated by 17<sup>th</sup> CAREC TSCC in April 2018
- Initial draft circulated to CAREC countries and development partners in March 2019, revised and approved by 18<sup>th</sup> CAREC TSCC in April 2019
- Further suggestions received during and after CAREC TSCC received in April-May, reviewed and incorporated
- Additional comments were received during and after CAREC SOM and integrated in the draft
- List of priority investment projects (Appendix 3) was further revised after consultations with DMC and developing partners





# Comments addressed in the draft Strategy after CAREC SOM

Comments/suggestions	Actions
The strategy shall give equal attention to improvement of transport infrastructure and transport sustainability	The draft Strategy was revised accordingly. The draft Strategy contains the list of priority investment projects, which will be periodically reviewed
The Strategy shall include one more pillar for the Maritime and Ports operations	Ports and Maritime operations are included in the Pillar: Cross-border Transport and Logistics. CAREC program started preparation of the Ports and Logistics Scoping Study.
Data on frequency of flights in the aviation section is outdated	Table was removed and replaced by the CAREC Aviation Framework diagram
Proposal to develop CAREC Cross-border Transport and Logistics Facilitation Strategy	Will be considered and discussed during preparation of the Ports and Logistics scoping study
Establishing logistics and industrial parks and developing SEZs shall be part of the Strategy	Included under the Pillar: Cross-border Transport and Logistics and will be further addressed by the Ports and Logistics scoping study
