CAREC Institute's Role in the implementation of CPMM

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Institutional and financing mechanism

- Engage key members in the CPMM team to support implementation effort so that CAREC Institute can continue the CPMM implementation seamlessly. This includes
 - Hiring new staff and training Human Resources.
 - Designated staff allocation for CPMM.
 - Formation of cross divisional (RD, CBD and KMD) task force.
- Plan a field mission to visit all, or selected CPMM partners in CAREC and communicate the vision and involvement of CAREC Institute. This is a good chance for CAREC Institute staff to meet the CPMM partners and visit BCPs officially.
- Commission/extend TA to explore commercial means to strengthen the sustainability of CPMM.

CPMM Analysis and Publishing Annual Report

- CPMM flagship annual report will be published by CI.
 - CI's can play a greater role in the CPMM AR publication.
 - Cl's independence in publication we can do quick CPMM publications (CPMM AR, or policy briefs). Cl's policy briefs have generated more impact.
 - To check on quality, we do have internal publication board, we can utilize external review board if needed.
 - CPMM task force can be established to check the quality (ADB + CI members).



Administration and Implementation

- Develop an implementation schedule (ADB + CI) at the beginning of every year.
- Develop and maintain a comprehensive list of policies contributing to positive/negative effects to the TFIs.
- Develop and maintain a comprehensive list of infrastructure projects contributing to positive/negative effects to the TFIs.
- Develop and maintain a comprehensive list of CPMM recommendations (and corresponding actions) identified.
- Data collection and data management over a period of time.
- Data analysis and output production.
- Data dissemination.



Promotion & Marketing

- Organize a CPMM Symposium to attract researchers, academicians and multilateral partners to review progress, offer feedback and recommendations as well as co-develop new use cases for CPMM.
- Discuss with interested parties on CPMM collaboration. Possible partners include TRACECA, IRU, GIZ, USAID Trade Central Asia, Islamic Development Bank (IsDB).
- Organize CPMM workshops/policy dialogue, as needed, engaging CAREC region relevant experts and policymakers.

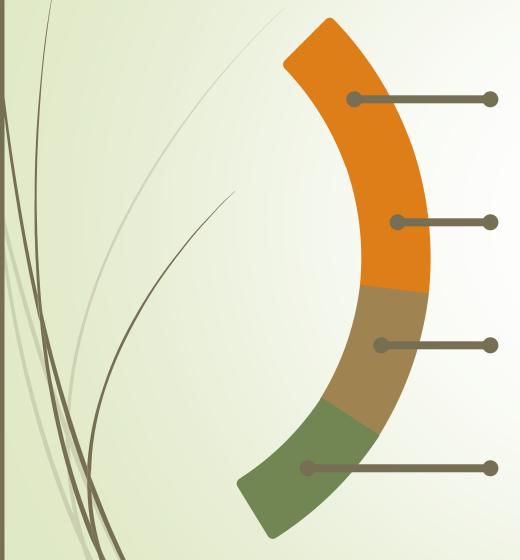
