 - Make amendment to a submitted CTD
 - Make partial release of cargo

3 Scenarios:

- 1 Intra-CAREC Movement
- 1 Import into the CAREC
- 1 Transit through the CAREC

Feedback:

- 1 High priority
- 2 Medium priority
- 1 Low priority





Conformity Test – Feedback

No.	Feedback	Action	Priority
1.	When making an amendment, it is important to identify what can be changed in the CTD and by whom. From a system security/integrity point of view, CATS need to limit the fields that can be amended to an agreed list of fields only AZ	The topic of which data fields are amendable has been listed as an agenda item for the Control Facilitation WG in Baku.	High
2.	It is important to allow several items (under different HS Headings) to be released for a trader, to achieve multiple-item partial releases AZ	We will look to update the system in future versions to reflect this feedback.	Medium
4.	The present setup envisages that the trader manually submits any CTD change request to Customs (outside the system), who then approves or rejects the change request. A transit Customs officer then updates the system with any approved change. In Azerbaijan, the law states changes can only made directly by a trader in Azerbaijan. It cannot be submitted via Customs for approval, and then a Customs officer inputs the necessary adjustments into CATS AZ	This will be discussed in Baku with members of the Control Facilitation WG for consideration in a later version release.	Medium
3.	Uzbekistan would like to see the description and HS code of a commodity under partial release on the customs control tab.	We will look at doing a pop-up to show the details at a future date.	Low
