

#### Legal Framework of AEO Implementation

#### International Instruments:


- The 2005 WCO Framework of Standards (FoS) to Secure and Facilitate Global Trade (revised in 2007, 2012, 2015, 2018 and 2022) Mongolia's Letter of Intent June 2005
- The 2006 Revised Kyoto Convention (1973 International Convention on Harmonization and Simplification of Customs Procedures) Mongolia ratified the 1999 Protocol and acceded to it in 2006
- The WTO Trade Facilitation Agreement (done in 2013 and entered into force in 2017) Mongolia ratified the 2014 Protocol in 2016 and acceded to it in 2017
- The Arrangement between the CGA of Mongolia and the GAC of China Regarding MR of the AEO Program in Mongolia and the Enterprise Credit Management Program in China (25 April 2019, Beijing)
- The Arrangement between the CGA of Mongolia and the KCS of ROK Regarding MR of the Respective AEO Programs (30 September 2019, Ulaanbaatar)
- MOU between Korea AEO Association (KAA) of the ROK and the CGA of Mongolia Regarding K-AEO Exportation and Capacity Building of Mongolia's AEO Programs (28 April 2023, Seoul)
- 2018 Draft GTI Standardized AEO MLA (Expected to be regional AEO MRA)



**Benefits Provided to AEO Operators** 

#### CGA Directive No. A118 dated 17 March 2021

- **1. Priority in Customs clearance**
- 2. Release of goods prior to declaring to Customs;
- 3. Temporary storage goods at own premises
- 4. Exemption of documentary and physical inspection up to 90%;
- 5. Permission of access to Customs automated information systems;
- 6. Deferred payment of Customs tax and duties;
- 7. Periodic declaration in certain cases
- 8. Designated Customs officer for AEO company;
- 9. Public announcement of AEOs as trusted trade partners;
- **10.**Facilitation in countries with Mutual Recognition Agreements.





