





3-Country Cross





SCO Agreement is Open to Neighboring Countries and its Implementation will legally support Regional Facilitation of Road Transportation

Proposals:

- Road transport is the Major problem of CAREC where most countries suffer from outdated infrastructure. We appreciate ADB's capital and technical support in improving "hardware" of member countries.
- Meanwhile, China appreciate ADB's efforts in facilitating transport agreement communication among members on the "soft" side.
 - China is active and open in improving legal framework of transport facilitation.
- Proposal: consolidate resources and avoid duplication.
