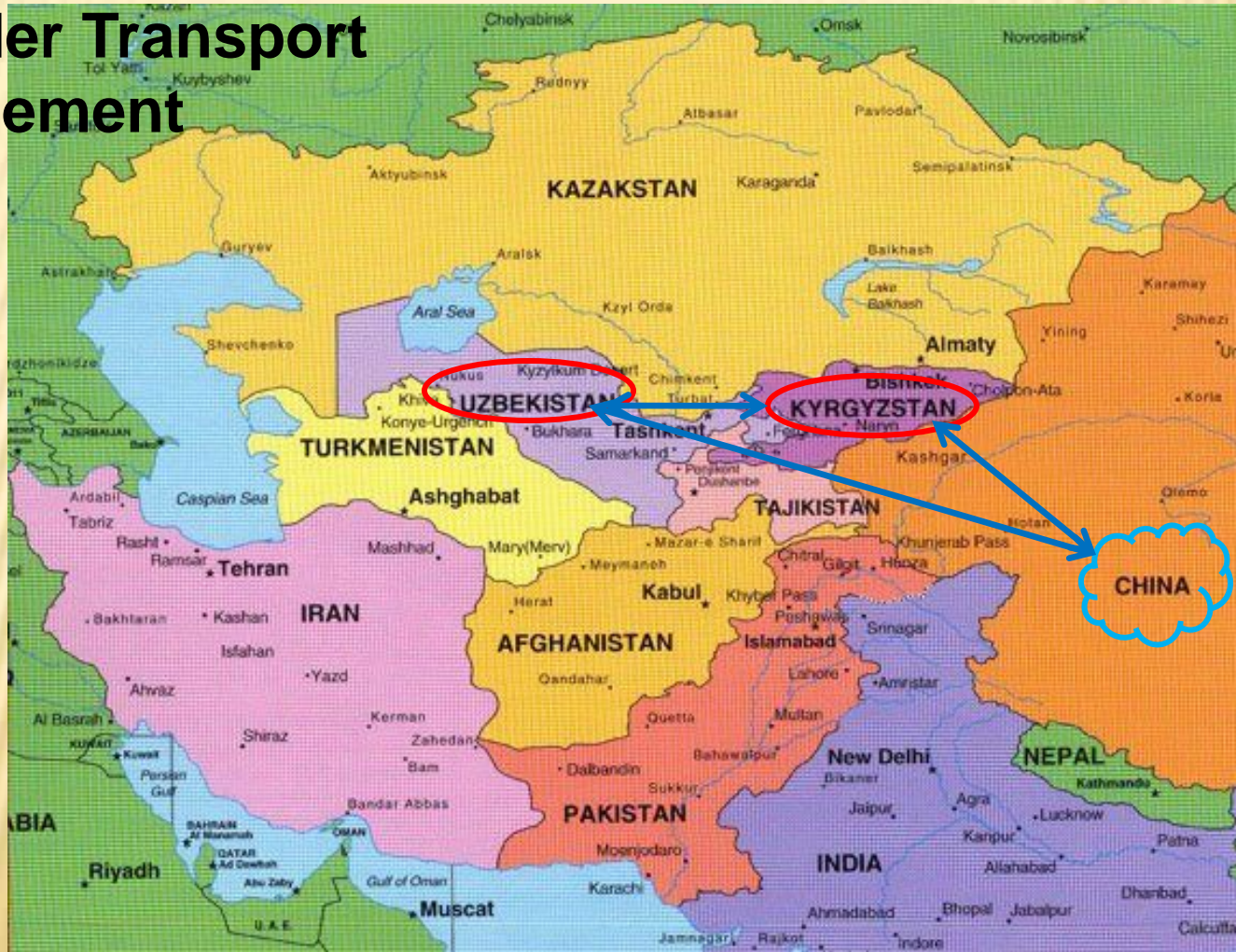

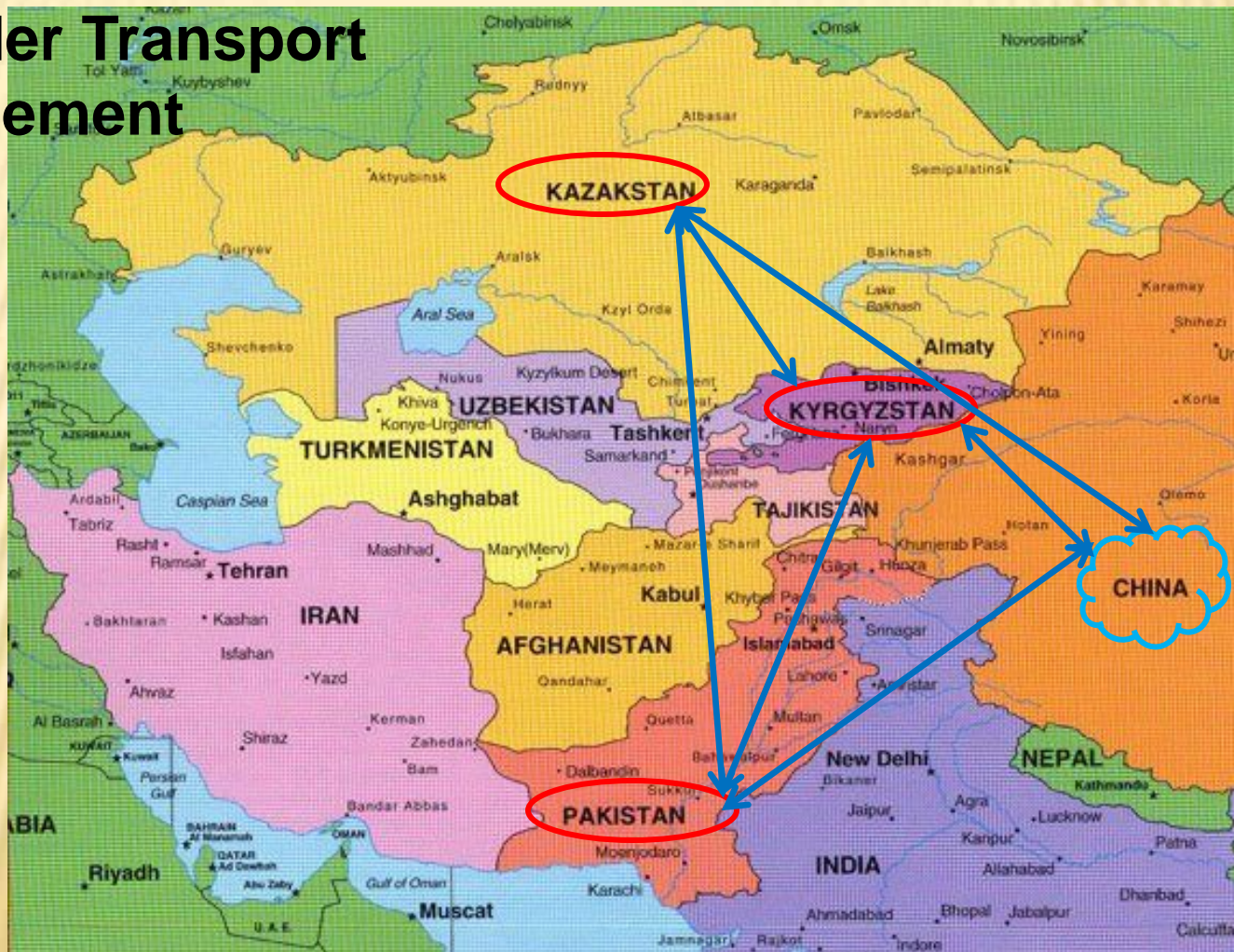

Proposals :

- Road transport is the Major problem of CAREC where most countries suffer from outdated infrastructure. We appreciate ADB's capital and technical support in improving "hardware" of member countries.
