Status Update - IT Technical Working Group

- □ The requested Customs office data has been provided by
 Azerbaijan and input into the CATS/ICE system additional data is now needed from the other countries
- □ Information is expected from Georgia regarding Version 5 of NCTS so a CATS/ICE comparison can be undertaken



Status Update – Customs Control Facilitation Working Group

- Scenarios to be Used for the Testing Phase of CATS/ICE based on CPMM data have been identified and Azerbaijan have also provided proposals
- Country responses to the RM questionnaire circulated in December 2023 are still pending
