


Thrust


#### **Overall Institutional Framework**











- Cross-border or domestic
- Almaty-Bishkek Corridor Initiative (ABCI)
  - -MoU signed in 2014
  - In 2016, ABCI Investment Framework endorsed by MC

## Supporting Industrial Park Development in the CAREC Region

• A TA to improve policy framework for Special Economic Zones and Industrial Parks (SEZs and IPs) in Kazakhstan and the Kyrgyz Republic

#### • 2 Outputs:

- -Diagnostic studies of KAZ and KGZ's SEZs and IPs
- -Strategic frameworks for industrial park development

#### **CAREC Institute (CI)**

- In Oct 2013, the 12<sup>th</sup> Ministerial Conference accepted the PRC's offer to host the CI in Urumqi.
- In Nov 2015, Cl's 3<sup>rd</sup> Governing Council Meeting endorsed Cl's Operational program for 2016.
- By end-2015, Cl's full management team was on board.
- In Oct 2016, Cl's Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) was signed by 4 countries in Islamabad.

CAREC Portfolio Cumulative 2001–2016 (By financier, in \$ million)




Over \$29.4 billion worth of CAREC-related investments have been made.
