1. AEO program awareness



AEO Authorized economic operator "AEO" program:

- 2005 session of the Council of the WCO: "SAFE Framework of Standards to Secure and Facilitate Global Trade",
- "Customs-Business Partnership",
- Ensuring trade security, supporting compliance, and expanding cooperation in customs-business

(SAFE Framework of Standards to Secure and Facilitate Global Trade (SAFE Framework)) Purpose:

- Secure and Facilitate Global Trade;
 - create customs, government and business partnership to jointly implement 29 standards;
 - Promote capacity building program consistently.



1. AEO program awareness



Mutual Recognition Arrangement/Agreement (MRA):

An agreement between customs authorities to establish and mutually recognize the trade facilitation benefits of an AEO duly obtained from one customs authority to another, and mutual obligations and responsibilities..

Customs -to-Business Partnership (C-2-B):

One of the 3 pillars of the Security Standards, promoting customs and business partnerships, creating a climate of close cooperation and shared responsibility, protecting our borders and promoting trade.



1. AEO program awareness



Authorization: Establish compliance with the international core standards included in the set of standards in order to:

- -Checking and validating the safe operation of documents and physical objects (equipment, etc.) in the workplace at the request of the enterprise,
- Procedure for recognition of legal status of AEO by customs authorities

AEO: is a party involved in the international movement of goods in whatever function that has been approved by or on behalf of a national Customs administration as complying with WCO or equivalent supply chain security standards.

AEO can be: Producers, importers, exporters, brokers, carriers, port, airport, terminal managers, warehouse managers, freight forwarders...








International legal framework:

- International Convention on Simplification and Harmonization of Customs Clearance Procedures (adopted *in Kyoto, Japan in 1973, ratified by Mongolia in 2006);*
- WTO Trade Facilitation agreement (entered into force in 2017,ratified by Mongolia in 2016);
- WTO SAFE Framework of Standards to Secure and Facilitate Global Trade (SAFE Framework) (approved by the WTO Council in 2005 in Brussels, Belgium);
- Mutual recognition agreement (Mongolian Customs signed with China's Customs on April 25, 2019);
- Mutual recognition agreement (Mongolian Customs Organization signed with the Republic of Korea Customs Organization on September 30, 2019);
- Memorandum of Understanding (Mongolian Customs Organization signed on April 28, 2023 with the Trusted Operator of the Republic of Korea).

National legal framework:

- Law on Customs, 271 ^{1.}1.16, (2008);
- "Procedure for granting customs accreditation to enterprises that meet trade facilitation and security standards" approved by order No. A/118 dated March 17, 2021.


2. Legal framework



- priority customs clearance;
- temporary storage of the goods in the owner's premises, warehouse or premises;
- a certain exemption from inspection of goods;
- In some cases, customs clearance of goods by bundling them under one customs declaration;
- designated customs officer to assist in resolving issues related to customs law and customs oepration;
- customs clearance at any customs office, regardless of the location of the goods;
- benefits in countrties with AEO Mutual Recognition Agreement.

- WCO Revised Kyoto Convention, Chapter 7, Chapter 9, standard 9.4-9.7;
- Law on Customs, Clause 268 ^{1.1.11}.


