### WTO TRADE FACILITATION AGREEMENT

 Trade Facilitation Agreement concluded at Bali Ministerial Conference(December 2013).

 Came into force on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2017, when 2/3 members have ratified it.

Pakistan Ratified TFA in October 2015.

#### PAKISTAN STATUS ON TFA

- A Capital Based Working Group under National Trade & Transport Facilitation Committee was established in February 2014 to divide the technical commitments in Category A,B and C.
- Capital Based Working Group comprised of representatives of Ministry of Commerce, FBR, Ministry of National food ad security, Ministry of Science and technology, Ministry of Communications, Ministry of ports and shipping, Chambers of Commerce

#### Category A:

Pakistan Notified its category A commitments in October 2015.Effort has been made to include all the measures in category "A" to which Pakistan is already Compliant.

#### Category B &C:

The category B&C Commitments was initially drafted in November 2015 and remained under consideration of the stakeholders till April 2017 and notified to the WTO Secretariat on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2017.
