

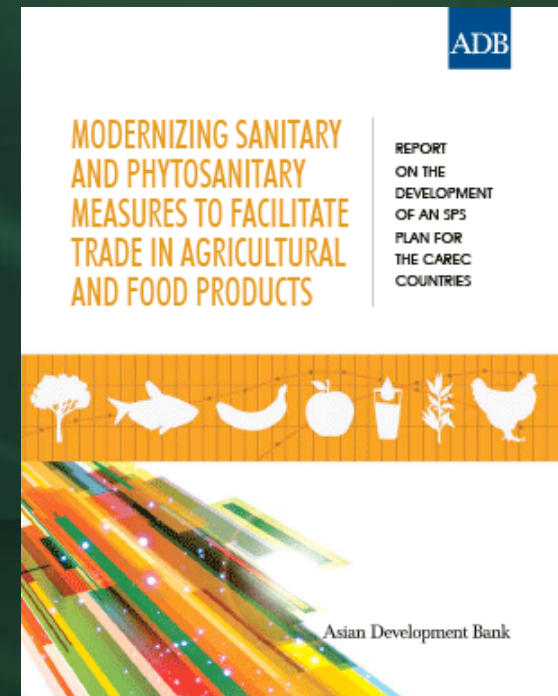

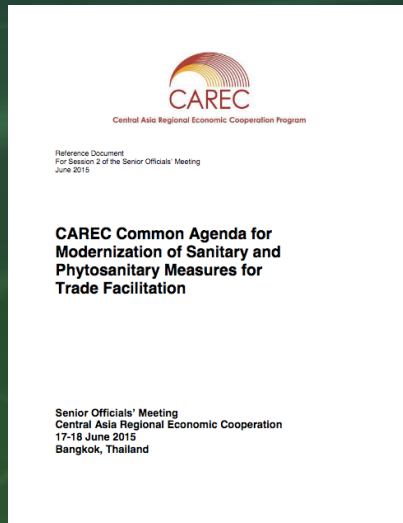

Completed Initiatives

- Joint Control of Transboundary Animal Diseases in People's Republic of China and Mongolia (TA 8220), 2012
 - Strengthened collaboration between the 2 countries
 - Developed training manuals and trained trainers, paravets, and herders
- Developing an SPS Plan for CAREC (RSC-C13610 REG), 2013
 - Reviewed SPS-related policies of 5 countries
 - Evaluated diagnostic and testing capacities of labs
 - Determined training needs



Completed Initiatives



- Promoting Cooperation in SPS Measures for CAREC (TA 8386), 2014

- Assessed the SPS regulatory framework, laboratory capacity, and border management
- Identified investment needs for modern SPS systems
- Served as basis for the CAREC Common Agenda for Modernizing SPS Measures



- Scoping Mission in Kyrgyz Republic for Regional Upgrades of SPS Measures for Trade, 2017

- Determined KGZ needs and areas of investments
- Identified priority actions including types of assistance needed

Ongoing Support 1

- Modernizing SPS Measures to Facilitate Trade (TA 9500), 2018

Objective: To help implement the Common Agenda to modernize SPS systems

3 components:

1. Organize SPS Working Groups
2. Align national SPS measures with international standards



3. Improve technical capacities for SPS management at selected common borders

- Strengthening International Food Safety Standards in Agricultural Value Chains in CAREC (RETA 9274)

Ongoing Support 3

- Regional Upgrades of SPS Measures for Trade (RUST) in Mongolia (Loan 3313)
 - Improve SPS systems to increase agri-food trade and diversify the economy
 - <https://www.adb.org/projects/46315-001/main#project-pds>

Output 1: laboratories and border inspection and quarantine facilities upgraded

- Construct 3 new lab buildings, rehabilitate 2 labs – technical proposal stage
- Provide 5 labs with new diagnostic equipment – TORs for supplier
- Construct animal inspection areas at 2 border crossing points – technical proposal stage
- Construct quarantine and disinfection facilities at 2 border crossing points – 2019
- Train 100 lab staff – 2019 and 2020



RUST in Mongolia (continued)

Output 2: SPS inspection management system established

- Develop and operate the SPS inspection management system (IMS) – business process analysis conducted with recommendations
- Integrated risk-based inspection into IMS – under study



RUST in Mongolia (continued)

Output 3: SPS control and inspections aligned with international standards

- International accreditation of laboratory tests – ISO assessment of laboratories of General Agency for Specialized Inspection (GASI) and Veterinary and Animal Breeding Agency (VABA) was conducted
- Develop lab manuals for testing and sampling techniques in line with international standards - 2019
