### Introduction: Transport Facilitation

- Concept: tool
  - for efficient cross-border movement
  - not for trade/immigration policy
- Scope: mode, subject matter, type of operation, corridor or territory
- Goals: efficiency time, effort, cost reduction



### Achieving Transport Facilitation

- Giving up some national sovereignty/identity to overcome social and economic isolation
- Giving up some control by authorities, but set off by other safeguards of national interest



### **General Principles Transport Facilitation**

- Cost related charges only:
  - no trade policy instrument
  - no income generating source
- Customs union does not cover all aspects
- Supranational instrument only sets minimum
- No discrimination



#### Transport Facilitation Elements

- People: visas + driving licenses + health
- Vehicles: registration + technical standards + roadworthiness + insurance + customs temporary admission
- Transport operators:
  - quota if necessary
  - no permits



#### Transport Facilitation Elements

- Goods:
  - definition prohibited/restricted
  - (phyto)sanitary
  - customs transit
- Procedures + documents: harmonization and simplification
- Interchangeable language, measurement, ICT, currency

#### Transport Facilitation Elements

- Institutional arrangement:
  - supervision
  - collecting user complaints
  - discussion platform
- Infrastructure, facilities, equipment: harmonization
- General political-social-economic environment for safety, fighting of corruption, transparency regulation

### Transport Facilitation Public-Private Sector Relationship

- Authorities at the service of the users
- Private sector:
  - involvement in legislative process
  - representation in institutional arrangements



## Choice between bilateral/regional /international instruments

- International:
  - opening to world
  - but too onerous
- Bilateral: difficult to organize three-country transit
- Regional:
  - tailor made
  - light version of international model



### Transport Facilitation Other Issues

- Dissociation from other political ambitions, international interests, trade and immigration policy
- No unrealistic reliance on ICT
- Willingness to change national legislation
  - clear commitments
  - no reference of unresolved issues to other instrument or forum
  - no sidetracking of normal domestic approval procedure
