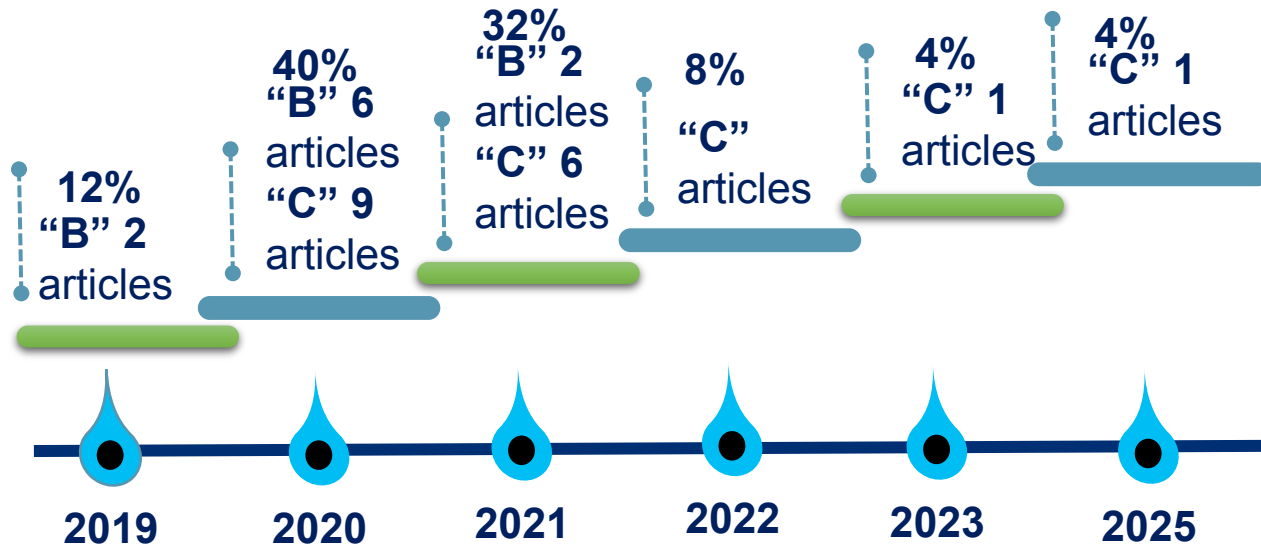

- Paperless clearance;
- E-payment (Connection with major 8 banks of Mongolia);
- Non-intrusive equipment at the main ports;
- E-clearance; and
- Exchange information between neighboring countries Customs Administration

- Capacity building development;
- Continuous training; and
- TRS (every 2 year, October 2019).

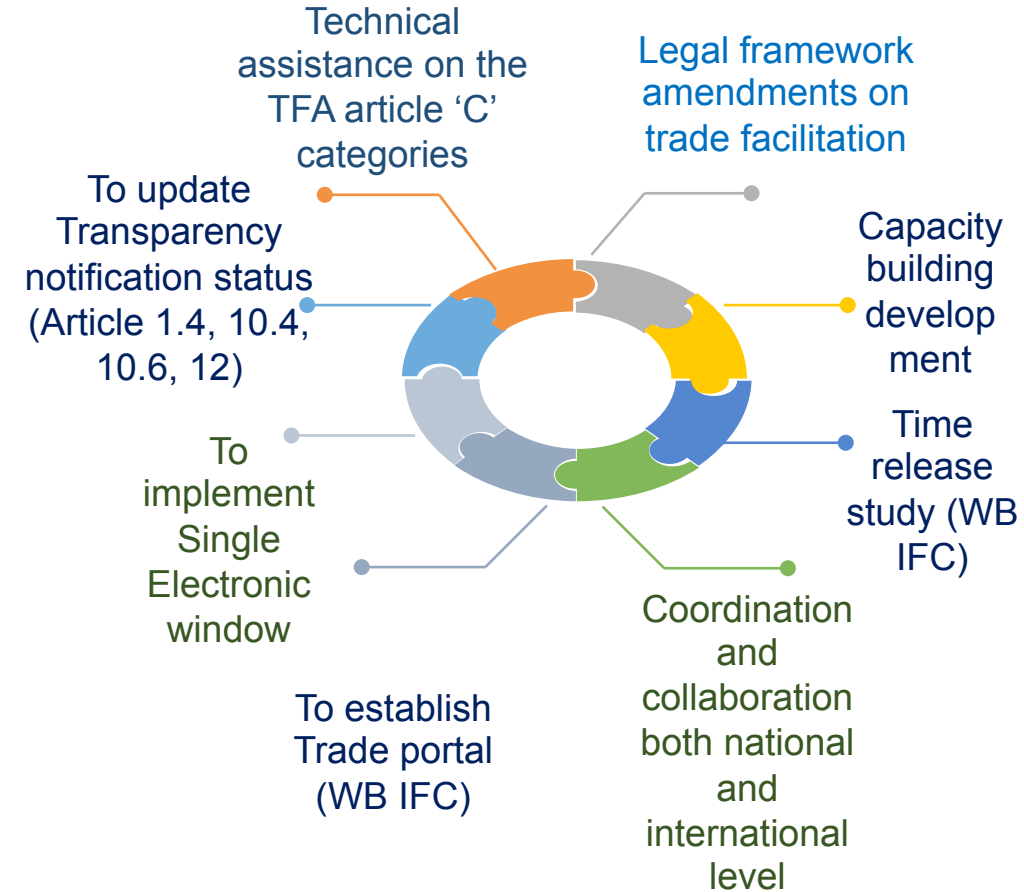
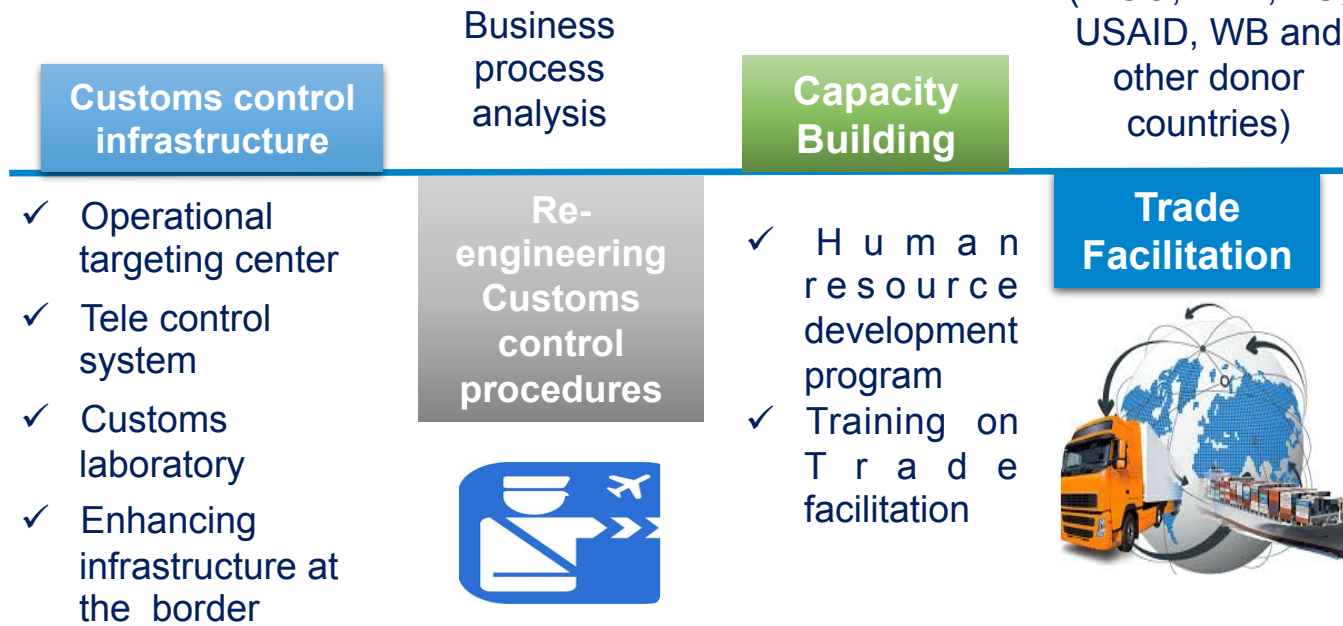
