Pakistan's Vision For International Trade

- Pakistan envisions creation of trading ecosystem based on the pillars of trade facilitation and increasing the ease of doing business.
- Increasing trade volumes by focusing on regional connectivity, automation and modern infrastructure



TFA Implementation Status

- Pakistan's Commitment Under TFA Category A -26% Category B - 43% Category C -31%
- Category A: Complied upon enforcement of TFA
- Category B: Complied
- Category C: Partially Complied,
 Technical Assistance required



National Single Window (Article 10.4)

- A National Single Window (NSW) is a facility that provides all stake holders of trade and transport a single operating platform in an automated environment.
- Pakistan committed to implement its NSW program by 2022.
- Customs has been designated as the Lead Agency to implement NSW Subsequently



National Single Window (Cont.)

- Customs designated as the Lead Agency to implement NSW Subsequently
- Strategy document and implementation plan prepared
- High level oversight Steering Committee headed by Minster for Finance and Revenue including key public and private stakeholders constituted.







Future Road Map

- Launching NSW by 2020
- Completion of ITTMS, a \$300 M project jointly funded by GOP and ADB (CAREC)
- Launching of Authorized Economic Operator (AEO) Program



Recommendations FOR CITA

 NSW may be included in CITA 2030- A request for the provision of technical assistance grant for design stage has already been forwarded to ADB

 AEO is another area that can be included in CITA with funding at design and development stage
