## **PAITS - Rationale**

- **Provide information to policy makers, farmers, service providers (including Veterinary Service) and others (consumers) to make informed decisions and to implement suitable plans for improvement**



## PAITS – Benefits

### Animal Traceability

- Food safety and quality control
- Value addition to products
- Export and certification

### Performance Recording

- Establishment of baseline animal performance levels
- Evaluation of production system alternative
- Individual animal management
- Genetic improvement

### Animal Health Information

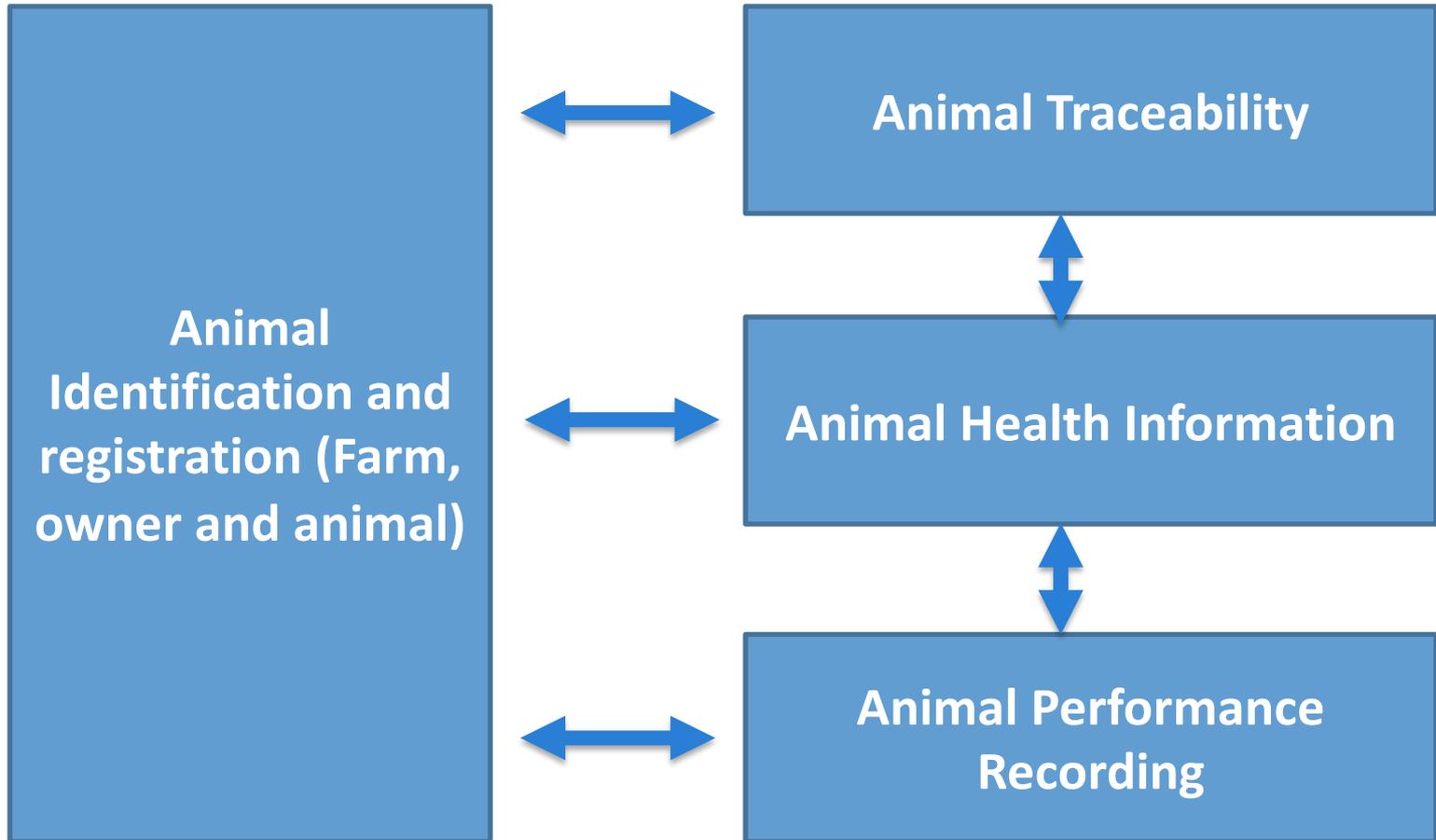
- Disease prevention and control
- Estimation of economic losses
- Management of veterinary health

### Other Benefits

- Authentication, preventing stock theft and locating and rescuing animals in disaster struck areas
- Managing payment of subsidies and preventing fraud
- Animal insurance

## **Output 2: Legal framework for PAITS reviewed and required improvement suggested**

- **Activity 2.1:** Review of legal framework of federal and provincial governments relating to animal identification and traceability
- **Activity 2.2:** Draft model primary and secondary legal framework at federal and provincial level



## **Output 3: Pakistan Animal Identification & Traceability System (PAITS) developed and demonstrated in selected livestock farming systems**

- **Activity 3.1:** Development of a database for animal identification and traceability System
- **Activity 3.2:** Piloting of the PAITS in different livestock production systems
- **Activity 3.3:** Liaison with slaughterhouses and diagnostic labs
- **Activity 3.4:** Training and capacity building



## **PAITS – Implementation arrangements**

- **FAO Representative** the budget holder
- **MinNFSR** appointed **Dr. Muhammad Akram**, Animal Husbandry Commissioner as **National Project Coordinator**
- **Provincial Livestock Departments** to undertake field activities with their existing staff
- **National Consultants:** animal identification, animal traceability, database expert, legal affairs
- **International Consultants:** Animal identification
- **Equipment:** Computers (2), Field data entry devices (16)
- **Capacity building:** Data entry and maintenance of database



## **PAITS – Where are we?**

- **Inception workshop held on 26 Aug 2021 in which all provincial livestock departments participated**
  - **All provinces endorsed the concept of PAITS and agreed to implement**
  - **Provinces agreed to select the union council for demonstration of the system in smallholder livestock farming**
  - **Capacity building of the stakeholders to be undertaken**
- **Letter of Agreement being signed with Punjab Information Technology Board for development of database and input Apps**
- **PAITS to be implemented in selected Union Council from each province, corporate livestock farms, commercial livestock farms and feedlot fattening farms**
- **Model legal framework component will be developed for federal and provincial governments**
