
OUR PURPOSE




The features of the ePhyto solution



The three pillars of the ePhyto solution	Central server	A central server (the ePhyto Hub) located at the FAO premises that allows the exchange of ePhyto between National Plant Protection Authorities
ePhyto Improving Sefe Trade in Plants and Plant Products	Web-based generic system	A web-based generic system (the GeNS) that can produce and receive ePhytos, to allow countries that do not have a national electronic system to produce, send and receive ePhyto
	Standard	A standard (the ISPM 12) for the structure and transmission of ePhyto with a harmonized format for mapping, codes and lists

Connection to single windows to allow customs to see the ePhyto










84 countries successfully exchanging ePhytos (August 2023)
