

Single Window Information System in Tajikistan

Single Window Information System - SWIS

The Single Window Center operates in the form of the State Unitary Enterprise under the Customs Service of the RT

The Center was established in 2010 by the Government's Resolution

Current 26 specialists work in the Center; the Center has representation offices in four regions of the republic

Today 11 state agencies and one public organization are connected to the Center; they are involved in issuing permits for export, import and transit.

Single Window Information System - SWIS


In 2012 the European Union allocated funds for establishment of the system to automate procedures related to issuance of permits.

A European company was selected to implement this project in the Republic of Tajikistan

A system was developed consisting of 5 modules

Each module was named a "Portal"

Trader's Portal




Trader's Portal is used by:

- 1) An economic operator (entrepreneur). This users manages declarations and applications for obtaining permits or certificates. The user can be an individual or a legal entity engaged in external economic activities according to provisions of the Law on External Economic Activities of the Republic of Tajikistan.
- 2) A customs broker. This user has the right to represent multiple economic operators, manage declaration and relevant permits and certificates on their behalf, and submit customs declarations to the UAIS of the Customs Service.
- **3)** A SW authorized operator. This user inputs data from the application an supporting documents acting on behalf of the economic operator. That is, the users, who work for the USE SWC and in regional offices of the USE SWC are authorized to provide Single Window services.

Agency's Portal



The Agency's Portal is used by:

- 1) An authorized administrator of the SW agency. This user will be able to administer registered users of a specific SW agency. This user will be able to generate reports on processed application, including issued applications. He/she can create new users of the agency and do editing.
- 2) An operator of a SW agency. This user will be able to administer applications for obtaining permits or certificate submitted buy an entrepreneur or a customs broker.
- 3) A coordinator of a SW agency. This user coordinates applications for a specific expert or independently administers applications for permits or certificates submitted by an entrepreneur or a customs broker.


Agency's Portal - Key Functions






- ✓ A notification about a new application for a permit to an agency.
- ✓ A request for additional information, for example, to appoint the time and the place for a laboratory test.
- ✓ Managing laboratory examination.
- ✓ A request for payment (issuance of a permit, a laboratory examination, etc.).
- ✓ A pre-payment option.
- ✓ A response to the application for permits to the trader's portal.

Registration Portal




Administrator's Portal



- ☐ The Administrator's Portal is used by the SW Authorized Administrator.
- > This user will be able to administer all registered users of the SWIS, including the creation of new users of all agencies, brokers and SW authorized operators.
- > Besides, this user will be able to generate business reports.
- The user can administrate reference data and rules.
