








#### **Step 1 – Customs Laws and others**




- Customs Law

## Step 2 - Regulations and others




- Regulations, Rules, Government Notice, Administrative circular etc. - Published!

#### <u>Step 3 – Check Your Existing Practices</u>



- Check your practice
- If yes, insert "Practiced but not documented"
  - | Immediate follow up !

#### Step 4 - Evaluation and Decision



Completion of good reference material for your follow-up work

- Check the column left blank
- Consider ways to meet the requirements
   Immediately, in 3 years, in 5 years
   By law, by regulation, by circular etc
- Finalize strategy
