## Background: Questionnairebased Monitoring Tool

- Presented at the 11<sup>th</sup> TPCC
- A monitoring tool for progress toward meeting the TPSAP objectives
- Questionnaires for 2009-12 in line with the TPSAP timeframe
- Commitment to submit the questionnaire annually to the IMF



# End-2009 Targets

- Reduce the number of non-zero tariff bands to 6 (3 by 2012)
- Actual convoy costs calculations
- Actual paperwork costs calculations for road transport permits



#### Analysis of responses

- Response rate has improved significantly since Spring 2010
- Countries are encouraged to report on progress during the year



## Progress as of end-2009

- Number of tariff bands is 6 or lower in all reporting countries
- Completion of actual paperwork costs calculations: KAZ, KGZ, UZB
- Completion of actual convoy costs calculation: KAZ



# **Key End-2010 Targets**

- Eliminate quantitative restrictions on exports
- Eliminate or tariffy quantitative restrictions on imports
- Equalize VAT and excise rates for imported and local goods



#### **Key End-2010 Targets**

- Eliminate other duties and charges, taxes and fees applied to imports and exports
- Reduce average tariff rate (target of 10% by end-2011)
