



# First Direction of the «Top 30 Corporative Leaders of Kazakhstan» Program Implementation



45 projects are estimated at approximately **USD 54 billion**, including: 17 infrastructural projects with USD 18 billion sum total; 28 productive projects with USD 36 billion sum total.

3 projects are simultaneously inscribed in the lists of 22 and 30 breaking projects, 1 project has been divided into 2 as a result of AIS proposal

### The projects, which have already started and will be put into operation in 2008, with over USD 1400 million sum total

- 1. Sorts of rolling producing organization in Karagandy oblast
- 2. Super capacious tantalum powder producing organization in East Kazakhstan oblast
- 3. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Zhanakol reprocessing factory (shift to the 1<sup>st</sup> turn of planned production capacity)
- 4. Chromium ore dressing industrial complex in "Voskhod" ore deposit in Aktobe oblast
- 5. Production of metallurgical silicon from lode crystal in Karagandy oblast
- 6. Production of finished textile in South Kazakhstan oblast
- 7. Construction of "North Kazakhstan Aktobe oblast" interregional power transmission line

## The projects, which will be put into operation in 2009, with over USD 3000 million sum total

- 1. "Astana Schuchinsk" highway construction
- 2. Construction and exploitation of primary aluminum production factory in Paylodar oblast
- 3. Construction of the 2<sup>nd</sup> "North South of Kazakhstan" 500 kW power transmission line
- 4. Modernization of the national power grid (first stage)
- 5. Construction of ore dressing complexes and brass works factory (I turn) in Aktobe oblast
- 6. Construction of cement factory in Mangystau oblast
- 7. "GEGA" grocery and logistic center in Almaty City
- 8. Live farming complex jointly with meat processing plant and feed mill in North Kazakhstan oblast

The projects, which are given state guarantees and sureties

- 1. Construction of the Moinak hydro-electric power station (state guarantees in 2005 are USD 25 million and in 2006 USD 75 million)
- 2. Construction of the 2<sup>nd</sup> "North South of Kazakhstan" 500 kW power transmission line (state guarantee is USD 100 million)
- 3. Construction of "North Kazakhstan Aktobe oblast" interregional power transmission line (state surety is USD 165 million)

### Long-term crediting by Development Bank of Kazakhstan and Eurasian Bank of Development

- 1. Construction of "A" class tyres producing new factory in Astana
- 2. Construction of the 2<sup>nd</sup> "North South of Kazakhstan" 500 kW power transmission line
- 3. Expansion of Aktau port to north



#### **Recommendations of Expert Council**

17 infrastructural projects are selected to be supported with the purpose of further implementation without including them into Program List

#### The projects recommended for implementation

- 1. JSC "Kazakhstan Petrochemical Industries" Construction of the first integrated gas and chemical complex infrastructure in Atyrau oblast;
- 2. JSC "ORDABASY-NOKIAN TYRES" Construction of "A" class tyres producing new factory in Astana;
- 3. "KUN Renewables" Ltd Construction of polysilicon producing factory with 2500 ton yearly capacity in Astana;
- 4. "Lokomotiv Leasing" Ltd Construction of locomotive assembling factory in Astana
