# History



The higher education of customs in China has a history of more than one hundred years. It can be traced back to the Taxation School established by the Qing Dynasty government in Beijing in 1908 (which was renamed as Taxation Academy and relocated to Shanghai). This school was one of the first schools that provided professional higher education of customs.










# Academic Program of Common Higher Education

Shanghai Customs College has Customs Management Department, Customs Economy Department, Customs Law Department, Customs Foreign Language Department and Public Basic Teaching Department. There are 7 bachelor degree programs and 2 three-year education programs that belong to management science, economic science, legal science and literature. Currently, there are 1,712 full-time students.



# Faculty

Shanghai Customs College has 133 full-time teachers, including 17 professors, 36 associate professors. 40% of the faculty have senior professional qualification. 19 teachers have doctor degrees, accounting for 14% of the total faculty. 81 teachers have master degrees. The doctor and master degree teachers combined together account for 75% of the total faculty.






# Countries participating in Overseas Assistance Human Resource Development and Cooperation Programs from 2001 to 2008






## Comments and suggestions from the trainees
