

Investment in Uzbekistan National Highway will achieve US\$3,442.4 million in 2010–2015


- To be constructed and rehabilitated: - 474km of four-lane concrete-surfaced sections;
- 648km of four-lane asphalt-surfaced roads;
- 288km of two-lane asphalt-surfaced roads;
- 7 traffic intersections;
- 1910 meters of overhead roads and bridges.
- Upgrading axle load limit from 10 to 13 metric tons and road geometry parameters to the standard at the 896km road sections.
