Background

- □ 450 million USD more annual cost incurred in compliance with regulations for imports, exports and transit trade in 2019 as against South Asia averages*
- □ NSW notified by Pakistan as Category C commitment under TFA
- □ 75 OGAs mostly operating in manual environment no Port Community System**
- With trade volume of 2.4 million TEUs the LPCOs volume is 2 million per annum***
- NSW reduces cost, time, complication & improves transparency for trade and government
- Enables Pakistan to fulfill commitments under WTO's Agreement on Trade Facilitation
